Pelkey – Stated doing a good job with limited municipal knowledge. Appreciates dedication to persevere with enormous responsibility instead of walking away from the mess and continue moving the town forward.

Labreck – Requested that the board be included with all employee interview processes. Explained that the board is not attacking when requesting to be involved in Town Manager's responsibilities. Brought up a conversation that was held during an unscheduled executive session where the Town Manager stated that "I am the Town Manager"

Philbrick – Upset that information he privately requested was not provided without FOAA request or majority of board vote. Upset that he should be able to give direct orders to employees and department heads.

Pelletier – Would like Town Manager to take more recommendations from him. Upset that information the Town Manager did not have was not provided to him in a timely manner. Wants follow-through of phone calls.

Durepo II – Stated that communication has improved significantly with more email notifications and updates. Is frustrated with the Board's lack of knowledge of municipal laws. Wants to make a policy to mandate board inclusion of all staff interviews. Is encouraged with Town Manager's inner drive to make improvements and she's doing a damn good job.

Pelkey – Thank you to the SnowHawks, to the Public Works Director, to the Fire Chief and to the public for coming and making contributions.

Durepo II – Read a letter addressed to the Board containing complaints against Selectman Philbrick for raising his voice and ordering the Public Works Director to turn off engine of the old plow truck as it was being towed back onto the road and for later showing up at Public Works Director's office to raise his voice that his prior orders were not addressed. For creating a hostile work environment at the Town Office when he raised his voice to the Town Manager for not delivering his notices personally and for giving direct orders to the Clerks threatening to demand responses during board meetings. For yelling at other board members during board meetings. Durepo II then made a motion to direct the Town Manager to file a restraining order against Selectman Philbrick on behalf of the employees.
